May 6 & 13 - Lovers Point, Pacific Grove



From Hwy I South in Monterey, take exit 402B to merge onto Del Monte Ave toward Pacific Grove and continue onto Lighthouse Ave. (slight right). Continue onto Central Ave., turn right at 14th Street, then left on Ocean View Blvd. Lovers Point Park parking area will be on your right.

May 20 - Uvas Canyon County Park



From Highway 101, take Bernal Road west. Turn left on Santa Teresa Boulevard, right onto Bailey Avenue 2.3 miles, left onto McKean Road 6 miles south turn right onto Croy Road. Continue 4.4 miles, through Sveadal, to reach the Park entrance.

May 27 - Bernal-Culnac-Joice Ranch



The site houses a nature museum and community garden. Also a beautiful treelined creek setting and meadow. Take 85 East to Cottle, go right on Santa Teresa and left on Camino Verde Dr. Take a right and follow through neighborhood to end. Park on street.

June 3 - New Brighton Beach, Capitola

Take Highway 17 south to Santa Cruz. Head south on Highway 1.Take the New Brighton/Park Avenue Exit; turn left at the first stop sign (McGregor), then right into the park. \$10 per vehicle; facilities.



June 10 - Jackson Ranch, Gliroy

2 miles above Anderson Lake. From 101 South go East on Dunne Rd. towards Henry Coe State Park, cross over Anderson bridge, go 2 miles to Jackson Ranch on left which is on a hair-pin turn.



June 24 - Laguna Road

We will meet on the corner of Laguna Road off Santa Teresa Blvd. All the neighboring roads provide good vistas to paint.

Go East on 85 to 101, take exit 373 Bailey Ave, turn right on Bailey and left on Santa Teresa Blvd.




