The Los Gatos Art Association runs a weekly outdoor painting event every Monday each month.

The location changes every week. All mediums are welcome.

Upon arriving at each location, members will be there to greet you and start the session.

July 6: Lighthouse State Beach, Santa Cruz



Take 17 to Santa Cruz. Take Ocean Ave. to Soquel Ave. and go right to Front Street. Go left and stay to right to Light House State Park. Meet in lighthouse parking lot. Cliff settings with Light House and local people to paint. Head back to the Boardwalk, View paintings after painting.

Iuly 13: Vasona Park, Los Gatos



333 Blossom Hill Road, Los Gatos. Meet in fishing pier parking lot. Go through gate and take road going to the right (which runs parallel 17). Go straight do not turn until you see the parking on your left. Fee \$6 unless you have senior pass. View paintings after painting.

July 20: Hershel Abelman's house



I5155 Kennedy Road, Los Gatos. Take East Los Gatos exit and merge onto Saratoga Los Gatos Road. Take a left on Los Gatos Blvd (going north). Take the third right onto Kennedy Road. House is on the left. Park on Property. Stay for the Lone Tree Art Reception.

July 27: Villa Montalvo



Take Montalvo Road off Saratoga Los Gatos Road and follow it around to the end. Meet in parking lot #3 to left of Mansion. Once grand estate of Senator Phalen, Villa Montalvo offers a lovely Mansion surrounded by formal gardens. Stay and view each others paintings.

August 3: San Juan Bautista Mission



From Los Gatos, CA 85- S, Merge on US 101-S, Exit 156, go about 3mi, turn Left on Alameda at first light signal, Right on Polk St., left on 2nd St. Park in front of mission, stay for lunch and paint afterwards. Stay for lunch, view paintings

August 10: Harvey Bear County Park, San Martin



Take CA-85 S, merge onto US-101 S 13.9 mi, Take San Martin Ave. exit go .2 mi, make sharp left onto E San Martin Ave. go 1.5 mi, turn left at destination into parking lot. Stay and view each others paintings

August 17: Moss Landing



Working fishing harbor, old and new boats and interesting old buildings. Take 17 south to Watsonville exit. Go South past Watsonville and turn right at power plant onto Moss Landing Rd. Take the next right on Sandholdt Rd. Before bridge turn right into Moss Landing Harbor Parking lot. Stay for lunch at Phil's Deli.

August 24: Laguna Ave and Santa Teresa Blvd



Go East on 85 to 101, take exit 373 Bailey Ave, turn right on Bailey and left on Santa Teresa Blvd. Farm and Ranch land. Tree studded California hills. We will meet on the corner Laguna Road off Santa Teresa Blvd. All neighboring roads provide good vistas to paint. . Stay and view each others paintings.

August 31: Davenport Landing Road



Take Highway 17 south to Santa Cruz then head north on Highway 1. Go past the town of Davenport, to Davenport Landing Road. Turn left follow to the parking lot. Stay for lunch, decide where after paintings
